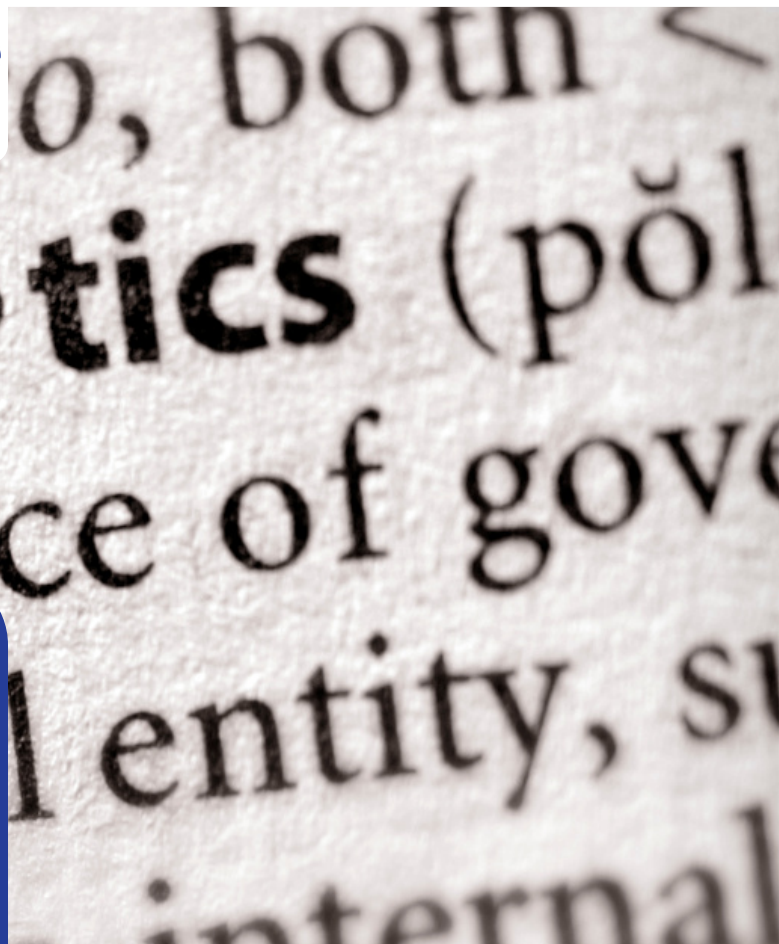




# Politics, Power and People
