



Transition Pathways Program

The Transition Pathways Program (TPP) is a specialised Stage 2 subject designed for students with verified disabilities who are aiming for post-school employment, supported employment, or further vocational training. Delivered in a small-group setting with dedicated SSO support, TPP equips students with adult independence through hands-on public transport training, industry site visits, and practical work placement.

PREREQUISITES: STUDENTS WITH A VERIFIED DISABILITY (UNDER NCCD), MINIMUM 60% ATTENDANCE, AND A CHOSEN INDUSTRY FOCUS. SELECTION IS DETERMINED BY THE INCLUSIVE EDUCATION TEAM.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

1. Learn to pre-plan and navigate multi-step public transport journeys (buses, trains, and trams) across Greater Adelaide.
2. Visit real-world work sites (such as Bedford, Barkuma, Grenville Hub, MTA, and local hospitality venues) while completing essential Work Health & Safety (WHS) training.
3. Develop job-seeking skills by creating a professional resume, writing cover letters, searching for vacancies, and participating in mock job interviews
