

# VISUAL ARTS - ART

Stage 1 Visual Arts is an introduction to a variety of media and explore techniques and develop skills. Students also explore arts concepts such as colour and media to communicate personally relevant ideas in a free choice major artwork.

Stage 2 Visual Arts focuses on developing the individual interests and passions of the student. There is an opportunity to research and explore a self-directed visual study, create a folio documenting the process of developing an idea through to a final artwork and practice technical skill in different media.
