



NASC Verification of Work

The below guidelines are taken from the SACE Board Supervision and Verification of Student Work Procedures <https://www.sace.sa.edu.au/teaching/assessment/verification>

By enrolling in NASC classes I agree that:

- All work that I submit for school and external assessment is my own, produced without undue assistance from other people or sources (i.e. artificial intelligence).
- Teachers must be able to verify that my work is my own through witnessing evidence of its production.
- If my teacher can not verify that work is my own, it is up to me to present evidence that the work was completed without undue assistance.
- If I cannot demonstrate that my work is my own, my teacher may assign an N (not complete) grade for that task. The following comment will be added:

Student has not provided evidence that the work submitted was completed without undue assistance.

- My teacher may allow the opportunity for me to complete an alternative task under supervision.
- Teachers who are unable to verify that the final piece of work submitted for assessment is my own work must initiate a breach of rules action, through the SACE coordinator.
- If I do not agree with my teacher's decision, I may lodge a grievance with the principal.

Steps for Teacher Verification	Evidence
<u>Preparation and Planning</u> <i>I have discussed my plan for the task.</i>	<i>In person or email/Daymap/text message conversations</i> <i>My planning notes, mind maps etc</i> <i>Gathering of resources/data</i>
<u>Progress</u> <i>I have demonstrated my progress in the task</i>	<i>Editing history of document</i> <i>Submission of formative work</i> <i>Discussion with teacher on the topic and scope of the task.</i> <i>Submission of drafts for feedback</i>
<u>Submission</u> <i>I have submitted my own work</i>	<i>Discussion with teacher regarding drafting process</i> <i>Reference List/Bibliography included</i>
